Before the Method there was a story. A factory in Getafe, a desk buried under deadlines, a green Walkman placed among the papers by a father who did not want to give advice, but to hand over a responsibility.

Alberto, the founder, gives Mapi three commands destined to change the way a company is led: **Play**, active listening to reality without filters; **Pause**, the courage to stop when external pressure tries to decide for you; **Stop**, the strength to close a cycle without staying hooked to what is over.
